

Analiza bazy Elsevier – Science Direct pod kątem materiałów wyszukiwanych poprzez słowo kluczowe „bibliotherapy”

Analysis of the Elsevier – Science Direct database – materials searched by keyword “bibliotherapy”

Abstrakt

Analizie zostaną poddane artykuły z recenzowanych czasopism naukowych wyszukiwane poprzez słowo kluczowe „bibliotherapy” (biblioterapia) w bazie Elsevier – Science Direct.

Abstract

In the analysis will be examined articles from peer-reviewed scientific journals searched by keyword “bibliotherapy” (bibliotherapy) in Elsevier – Science Direct database.

Przedmiotem niniejszej analizy będą materiały naukowe (w większości artykuły z recenzowanych czasopism naukowych) wyszukiwane poprzez słowo kluczowe „bibliotherapy” (biblioterapia) w bazie *Elsevier – Science Direct*. W analizie bazy głównej oraz jej podbaz (*Psychology, Arts and Humanities, Linguistics, Medicine and Dentistry*) zostaną podane następujące informacje: rok publikacji, tytuł czasopisma, temat, typ zasobu. Zostanie również przedstawiona bibliografia prac przypisanych do słowa kluczowego „bibliotherapy” w 2015 r.

Baza *Elsevier – Science Direct* zawiera elektroniczne wersje czasopism naukowych wydawanych przez Elsevier Science, w tym spisy treści, dane bibliograficzne, abstrakty oraz pełne teksty artykułów wraz z grafiką. Integralną część kolekcji stanowią czasopisma Academic Press oraz Harcourt Health Science. Baza umożliwia dostęp do pełnych tekstów z około 2500 tytułów, w tym 1579 czasopism aktualizowanych jest na bieżąco.

W bazie *Elsevier – Science Direct* do słowa kluczowego „bibliotherapy” przypisanych jest 1186 wyników wyszukiwania.

Podsumowanie

Wszystkie rekordy (1186) powiązane ze słowem kluczowym „bibliotherapy” wyszukiwane w bazie głównej Elsevier-Science Direct, a tym samym największa ich liczba, przypisane są do podbazy Linguistics. Druga z kolei największa liczba wyników (962) przypisana jest do bazy Medicine and Dentistry, następnie Psychology (795) oraz Arts and Humanities (38). Warto zaznaczyć, że wszystkie rekordy przypisane do obszaru lingwistyki, ukazały się głównie w czasopismach naukowych z dziedziny psychologii i medycyny. Fakt ten pozwala umiejscowić biblioterapię w obszarze nauk społecznych, jak i medycznych. Artykuły oznaczone słowem kluczowym „bibliotherapy” publikowane są w prestiżowych czasopismach z listy JCR a ich liczba systematycznie wzrasta, tym samym biblioterapia zyskuje rozpoznawalność i umacnia swą naukową autonomię.
